Please review these rules. Safety during any science class activity is of utmost importance. A student may lose the privilege of participating at any time for unsafe behavior.

## You are expected to know these rules and will only receive one warning before consequences are enacted. Removal from a lab activity results in a grade of Zero for that assignment.
